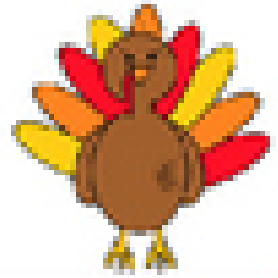

Happy November everyone!! Ahh, the smell of crisp air, morning dew, falling leaves, with a hint of cinnamon. Children begin to bundle up in scarves and parents begin to stock up on tissues. Make sure we are sharing more love than we are sharing germs, please! When the seasons change, as we all are very well aware, nasty little colds, flus, and other sicknesses love to make a home in our bodies. If you have a cough, runny nose, upset stomach, etc., that cannot be explained, make sure to rest!!!!

- 2 egg whites
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- ¾ cup light brown sugar, packed
- 2 tsp maple flavoring (optional, I use Allspice and Nutmeg)
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- ¼ tsp kosher salt
- 2 lb Pecan Halves



1. Preheat oven to 225°F. Line a 15 x 10 x 1-inch baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. In a large mixing bowl, beat egg whites until frothy, for about a minute using a whisk. Add in sugars, maple flavoring, cinnamon and salt. Mix again until well combined.
3. Fold in pecans, mixing until completely coated.
4. Pour pecans onto prepared baking sheet. Bake for one hour, stirring every 15 minutes.
5. Remove from oven and cool completely. Store in an airtight container lasts for about 1-2 weeks. ENJOY!
