Winter Break

We have a NEW SIGN-UP PROCEDURE for Holiday and Full Day Teacher Work Day Cares. Starting with Winter Break, all sign-ups moving forward for these days will be required to be made through your account online at www.myprocare.com. Please remember, we are not using the Procare App. Once you login to your account online you will see that, under Alerts, it will state that Registrations are available. Click VIEW to proceed to begin re-registration for your child for Winter Break 2023-2024. Once submitted you will receive an automatic email confirmation that your registration has been submitted. This confirmation serves as a record of your Winter Break site and dates signed up to attend. Payment then can be made online or at any FCCC location, due by the sign-up deadline (12/14/2023).

Illness Policy

It's cold and flu season! Please help us make sure everyone stays healthy by adhering to our Illness Policies.

- To remain in compliance with health and safety regulations, children must be free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to FCCC.
- If a child becomes ill while at FCCC they will remain in a designated quiet area and their parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up as soon as possible.
- Please remember to notify us within 24 hours if a child or member of your immediate household contracts a contagious illness. FCCC is required to post a written notice of the presence of the illness in the program. All identities will be kept confidential.

December is a very fun month for many reasons. Did you know that December 4th is National Dice Day, the 12th is Gingerbread House Day, the 17th is UGLY sweater Day, and the 28th is National Card Playing Day? With this in mind we are going to introduce dice and card games, and art activities to cover these events.

Here are the instructions for one of the Dice games, enjoy!

Pig (dice game)

The game of Pig is played with a single six-sided die **Gameplay**

Each turn, a player repeatedly rolls a die until either a 1 is rolled or the player decides to "hold":

- If the player rolls a 1, they score nothing and it becomes the next player's turn.
- If the player rolls any other number, it is added to their turn total and the player's turn continues.
- If a player chooses to "hold", their turn total is added to their score, and it becomes the next

player's turn.

The first player to score 100 or more points wins.

For example, the first player, Donald, begins a turn with a roll of 5. Donald could hold and score 5 points, but chooses to roll again. Donald rolls a 2, and could hold with a turn total of 7 points, but chooses to roll again. Donald rolls a 1, and must end his turn without scoring. Donald has a total of 7 points. The next player, Alexis, rolls the sequence 4-5-3-5-6, after which she chooses to hold, and adds her turn total of 23 points to her score. Each will continue until one reaches 100 points. Happy Holidays!


